CIRCULAR

Sub: Admission Criteria for Class XI in Govt./Govt. Aided Schools.

In supersession of earlier circulars dated 25-5-2010, 4-6-2010, 15-6-2010, 14-7-2011, 28-5-2012, 31-5-2016 & 07.06.2016, the admission criteria for Class XI in Govt./Govt. Aided Schools has been revised. All the Heads of Govt./Govt. Aided Schools are hereby directed to observe the following criteria while admitting the students in Class XI in various streams w.e.f. academic session 2017-18.

Students declared passed in the Secondary School Examination will be considered for admission to different streams in Class XI as per the following eligibility criteria:-

Science (with Maths)	6.4	English-B2	Maths-B2	Science-B2
Science (without Maths)	6.4	English-B2	Maths-B2**	Science-B2
Commerce (with Maths)	6.0	English-C1	Maths-B2**	Social Science-C1
Commerce (without Maths)	6.0	English-C1 OR Hindi-C1	Social Science-C1	_____
Humanities and Vocational	A student must have been declared passed at the Secondary School examination by the CBSE or its equivalent board. For giving Economics as a subject, a student must have, at least, 6.00 CGPA. For giving Maths as a subject, a student must have secured, at least, C1 grade in Maths without asterisk. Note:- Admission in Humanities is not to be denied to own students who have been declared pass in Class X examination.			


All Heads of Govt./Govt. Aided Schools are hereby informed that relaxation of 1 grade point in any one of the three subjects mentioned for admission in particular stream is to be given in respect of candidates belonging to the categories SC/ST/ Minorities/OBC(Non Creamy Layer)/Kashmiri Migrants & those students having I/II/III position in National Games

For Specially Abled Students, relaxation of 1 grade point in 2/3 (as per case) subjects mentioned for admission in particular stream is to be given.

Admission of Compartment students:- The schedule and procedure for admission of compartment students shall be completed within 15 days of the declaration of Class X Compartment Result as per above criteria.

The above criteria are for regular students. Students who have passed their Secondary Examination (Class X) from NIOS with 55 % marks or above in aggregate of 5 main subjects are eligible for admission in Vocational & Humanities streams provided they are below 17 years of age as on 31st March of the year. The HOS must also ensure the subject wise eligibility of the student for admission in Class XI as per required percentage of marks/CGPA, at Secondary Examination (Class X).

This issues with prior approval of the Competent Authority.
